FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB 104

Analysis

The proposed legislation creates a new Transfer on Death (TOD) title for a boat or vehicle for which the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is required or allowed to issue a certificate of title. This allows DMV to issue a designated beneficiary a certificate of title upon death of the owner.

The current DMV titling system will need to be reprogrammed and reconfigured to allow for the addition of the "transfer on death" or "TOD" language in this bill. Using information from a prior reconfiguration of a similar software change, DMV estimates it will take 600 programming hours at a cost of \$125.00 per hour, for a total estimated cost of \$75,000 to implement these changes.
