## **Analysis**

This bill proposes to increase the amount of information required to be provided by judicial retention candidates in the official election pamphlet.				
The Division of Elections is responsible for preparing, publishing, and mailing the official election pamphlet on a regional basis to each household identified from the official registration list. Should this bill pass, the increased amount of required information would add to the number of pages in the official election pamphlet for each of the five regions, thereby increasing translation and printing costs.
