SB 20: CPR Curriculum Sectional Analysis – Version N

<u>Section 1</u>- Amends AS 14.30.360(a) *Health education curriculum; physical activity guidelines.*

Removes Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) from this section.

Section 2- Adds a new section to AS 14.30 Pupils and Educational Programs for Pupils

Section 14.30.363. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation education. The department shall adopt curricula to instruct public school students on hands-only CPR. The department shall determine which grade levels are required to receive instruction under this section and adopt curricula that is appropriate for each of those grade levels. A person holding a current CPR instructor certificate, a license to provide emergency medical services under AS 18.08.082, or a current teacher certificate issued under AS 14.20 may present the curriculum to students. Each public-school providing instruction to students in grades for which this curriculum has been adopted shall offer the instruction. The curricula must:

- (1) be based on current national, evidence-based emergency cardiovascular care guidelines for CPR.
 - (2) incorporate hands-on practice in addition to cognitive learning;
- (3) include instruction in the appropriate use of an automated external defibrillator, which may be taught using video or other means if in-person instruction is not available.
