Analysis

This bill would require an annual report by the Department of Health to the legislature; however, there will be a requirement of data to be provided by DFCS to include children placed in Psychiatric Hospitals. This data is currently tracked and there would be no additional costs to the department.

However, DFCS may lack authority to collect data regarding minors not in its custody for purposes of reporting.
