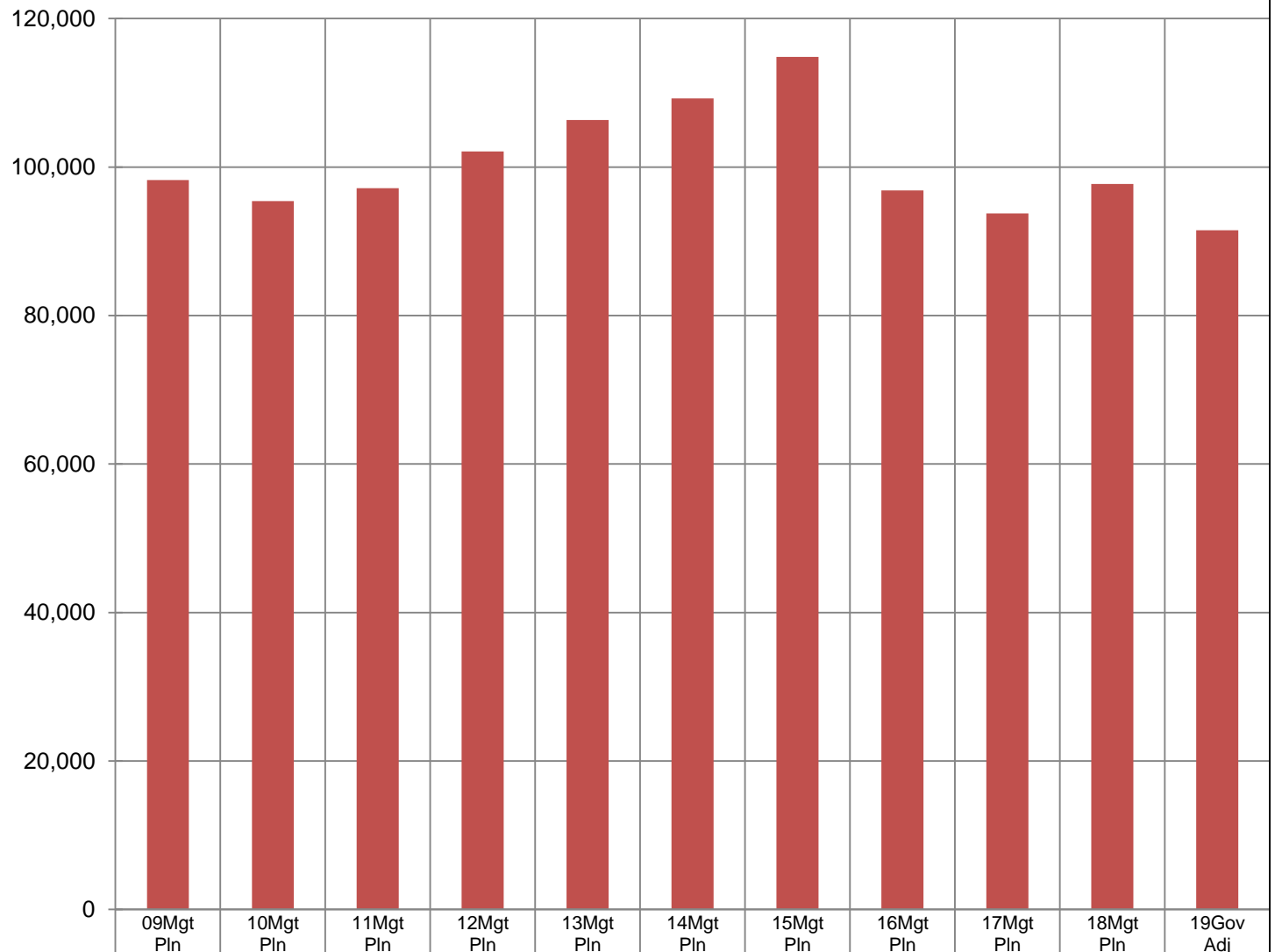

Department of Natural Resources Share of Total Agency Operations (GF Only) (\$ Thousands)

DNR's GF budget decreased by \$6.8 million between FY09 and the FY19 Governor's Adjusted Budget -- an average annual decline rate of 0.7%.

UGF decreased by \$15.9 million (21%), while DGF increased by \$7.6 million (33%).

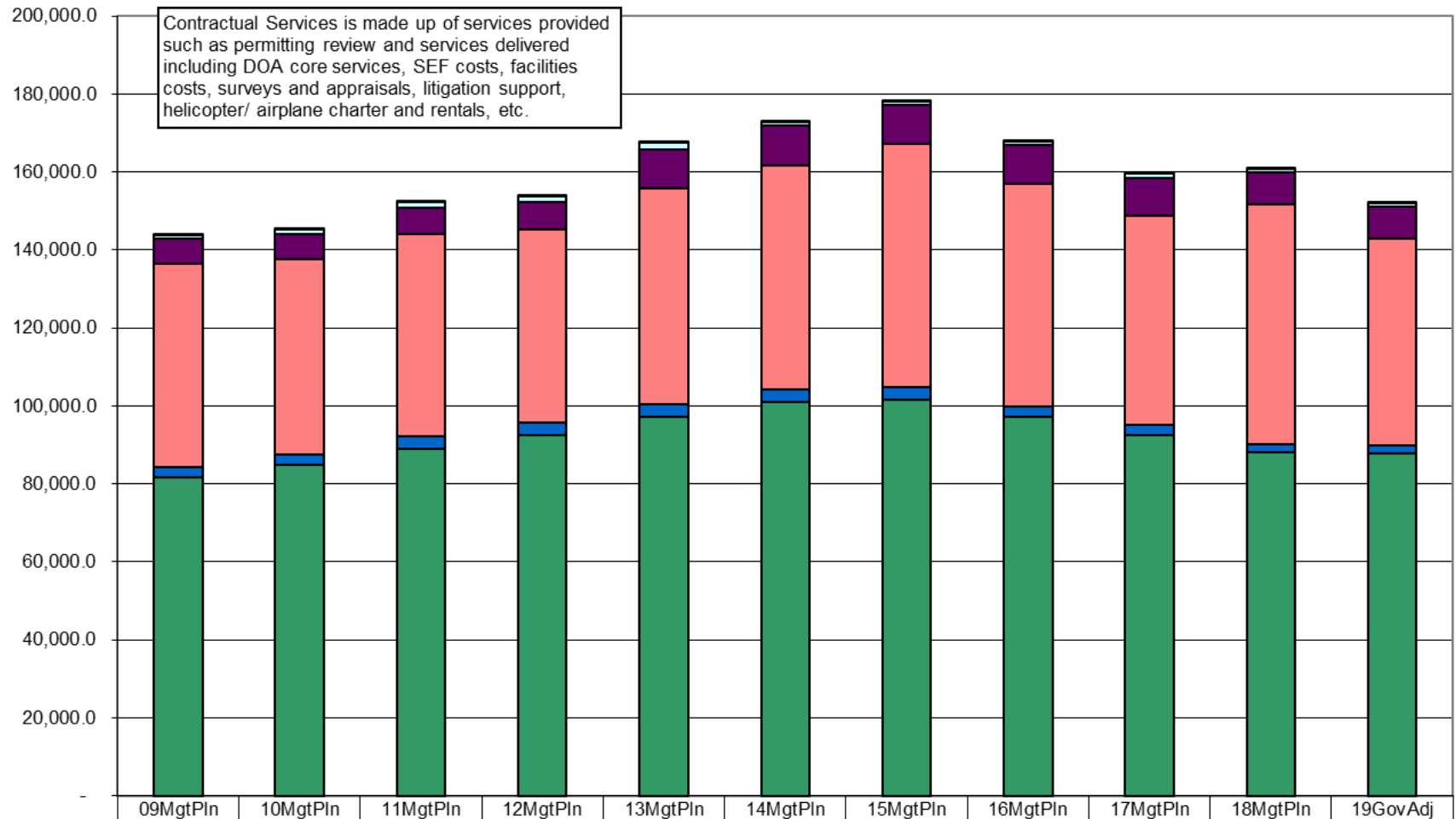
The FY19 Gov GF budget equates to **\$275 per resident worker** (based on 332,583 Alaskan workers).

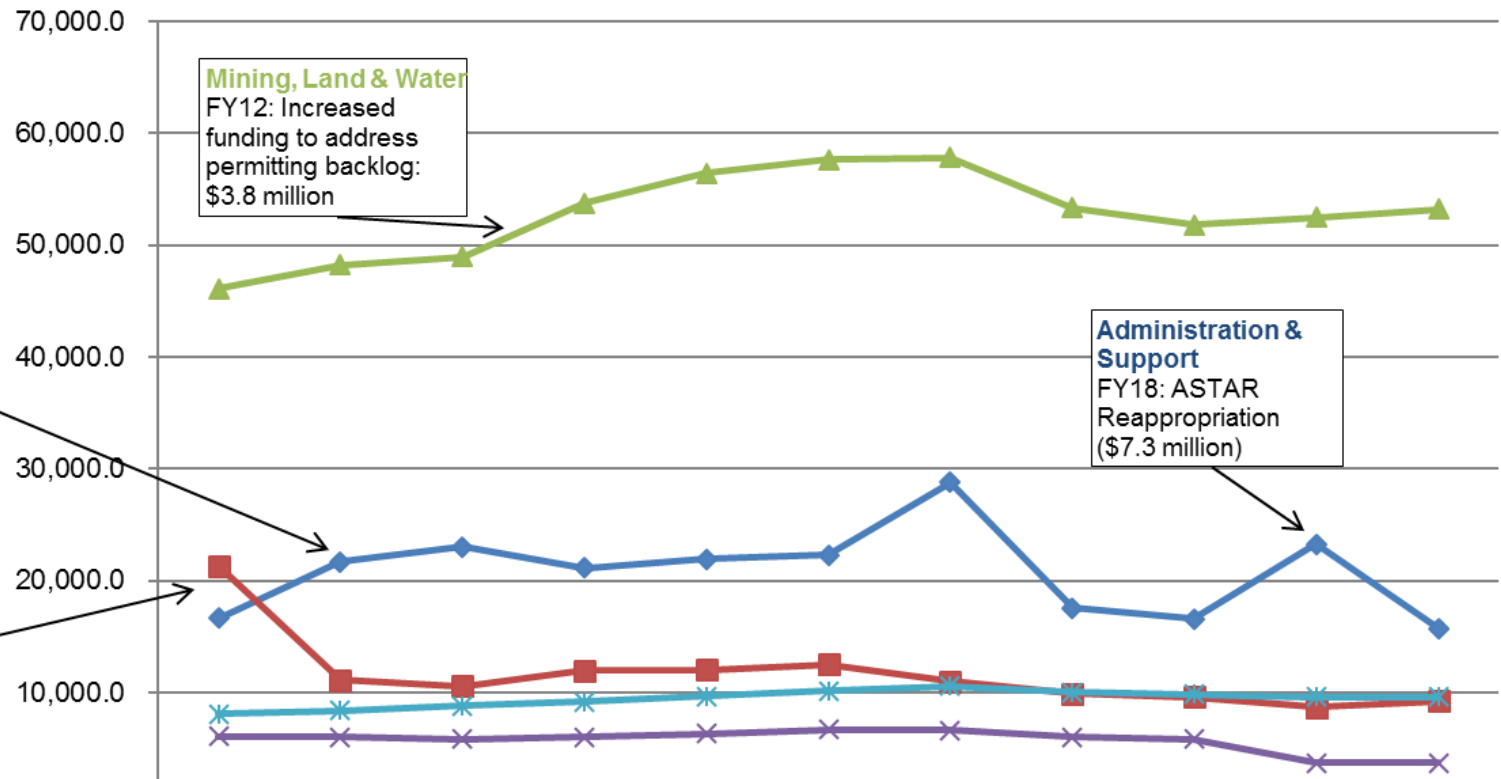

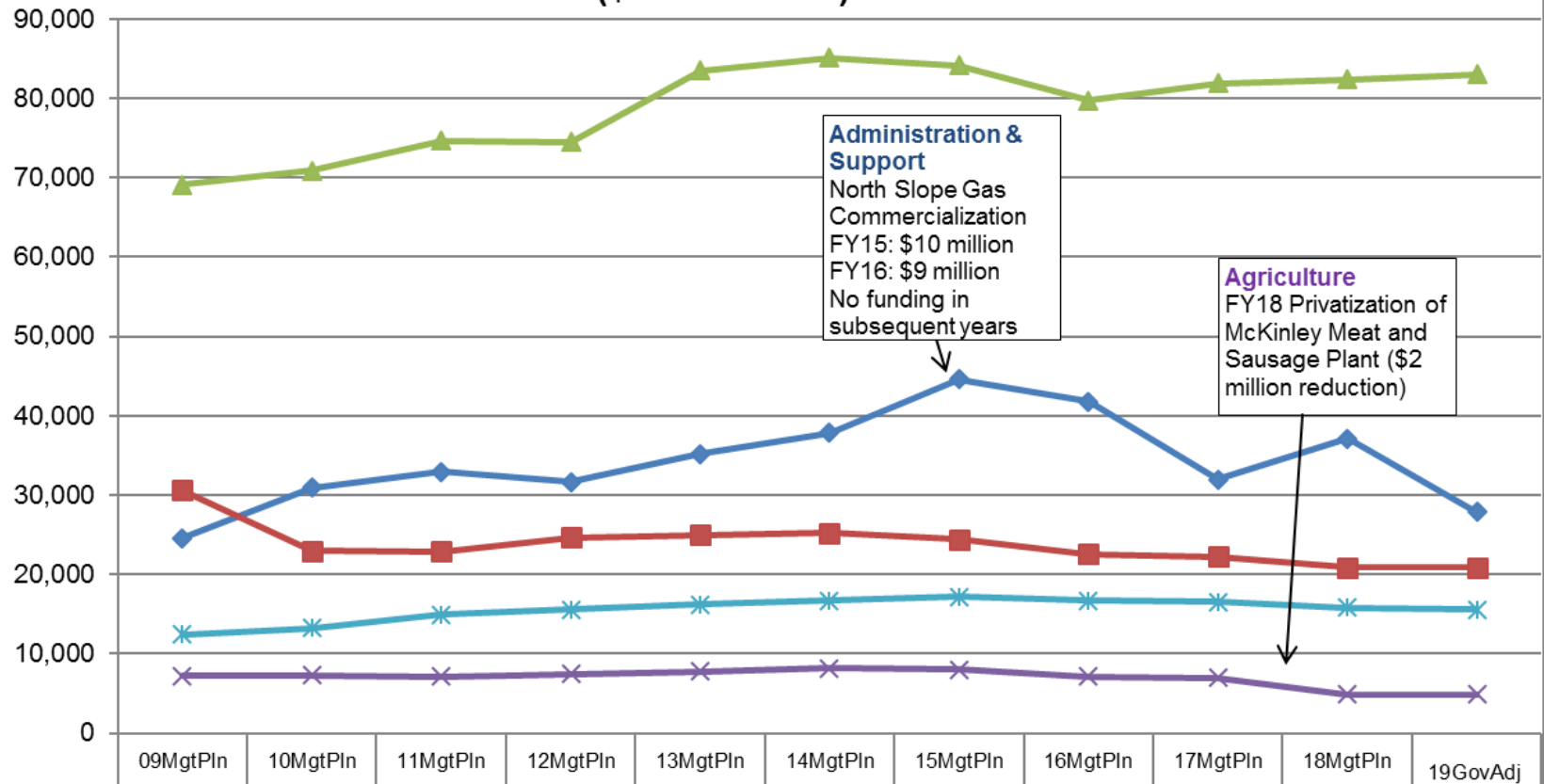

The number of appropriations increased from four to six, and the number of allocations were reduced from thirty-five to twenty-six.
