**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1    "An Act relating to criminal background checks for marijuana establishment  
2    registrations and renewals; and providing for an effective date."

3    **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4    \* **Section 1.** AS 17.38.200(a) is amended to read:

5                    (a) Each application or renewal application for a registration to operate a  
6    marijuana establishment shall be submitted to the board. A renewal application may be  
7    submitted up to 90 days before the expiration of the marijuana establishment's  
8    registration. When filing an application for a new registration under this subsection,  
9    the applicant shall submit the applicant's fingerprints and the fees required by the  
10   Department of Public Safety under AS 12.62.160 for criminal justice information and  
11   a national criminal history record check. When filing an application for renewal of  
12   registration, an applicant shall submit the applicant's fingerprints and the fees  
13   required by the Department of Public Safety under AS 12.62.160 for criminal  
14   justice information and a national criminal history record check every three

1       **years.** The board shall forward the fingerprints and fees to the Department of Public  
2       Safety to obtain a report of criminal justice information under AS 12.62 and a national  
3       criminal history record check under AS 12.62.400.

4       \* **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
