2 Delete "Alaska Native organization that is recognized by and eligible to receive
3 services from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs,
4 while providing dental hygiene services to a member of a tribe that is recognized by the
5 United States Secretary of the Interior under 25 U.S.C. 479a (Federally Recognized
6 Indian Tribe List Act of 1994)"
7 Insert "Indian health program, as that term is defined in 25 U.S.C. 1603, while
8 providing dental hygiene services to a person eligible for health services provided by the
9 Indian health program under 25 U.S.C. 450 et seq. (Indian Self-Determination and
10 Education Assistance Act)"

12 Page 18, following line 26:
13 Insert a new bill section to read:
14 "*** Sec. 36.** AS 08.36.350(a) is amended to read:
15 (a) This chapter applies to a person who practices, or offers or attempts to
16 practice, dentistry in the state except
17 (1) a dental surgeon or dentist in the military service in the discharge
18 of official duties;
19 (2) a dentist in the employ of the United States Public Health Service,
20 United States Department of Veterans Affairs, [ALASKA NATIVE SERVICE,] or
21 other agency of the federal government, in the discharge of official duties;
22 (3) [A PHYSICIAN OR SURGEON;
23 (4) A DENTIST PROVIDING CARE IN AN ISOLATED AREA BY

1 AUTHORITY OF A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER AS 08.36.271;

2 (5)] a dentist licensed in another state who is teaching or
3 demonstrating clinical techniques at a meeting, seminar, or limited course of
4 instruction sponsored by a dental or dental auxiliary society or association or by an
5 accredited dental or dental auxiliary educational institution;

6 (4) [(6)] a dentist licensed in another state who provides emergency
7 care to an injured or ill person who reasonably appears to the dentist to be in
8 immediate need of emergency aid in order to avoid serious harm or death if the care is
9 provided without remuneration;

10 (5) a dentist employed in the state by an Indian health program, as
11 that term is defined in 25 U.S.C. 1603, while providing dental hygiene services to
12 a person eligible for health services provided by the Indian health program under
13 25 U.S.C. 450 et seq. (Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act)."
