High School Students Who Made A Plan About How They Would Attempt Suicide*

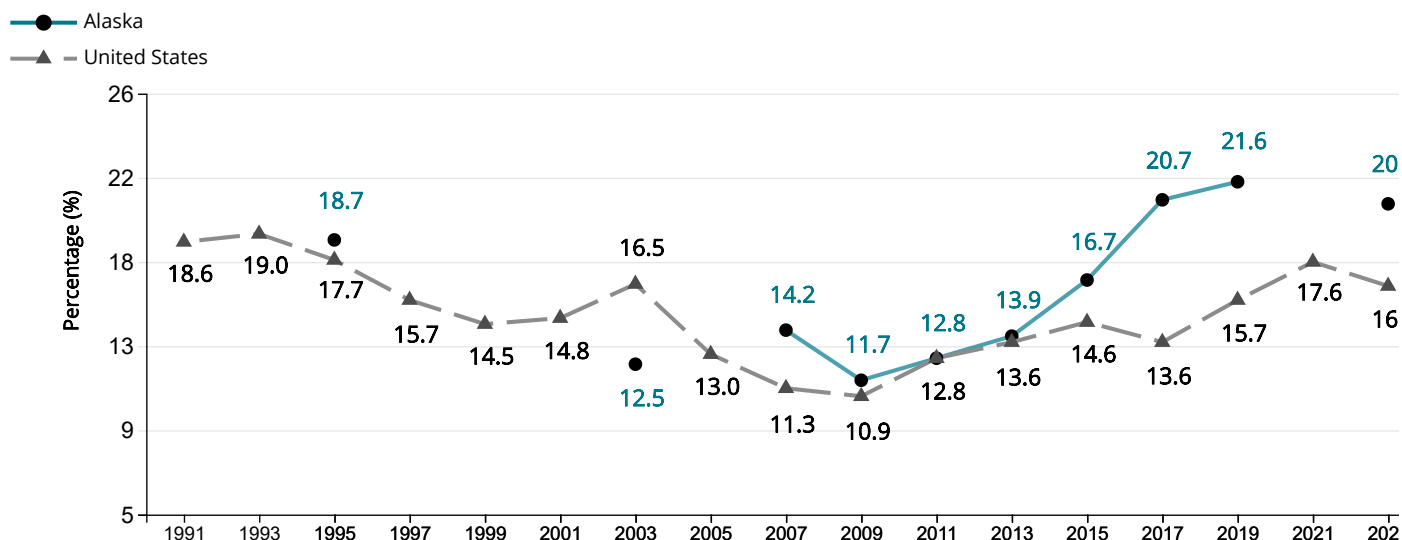

Patterns Over Time

We are tracking the prevalence of making a suicide plan over time.

Alaska observed an **increase** from 2003 to 2023.[†]

The United States observed an **increase** from 2003 to 2023.^{††}



* During the 12 months before the survey.

Missing data point indicates that data were not available.

† Overall, the percentage of students reporting this behavior increased from 2003 to 2023. The direction of the trend line did not change from 2003 to 2023. Any indicated increase or decrease is statistically significant.

†† Overall, the percentage of students reporting this behavior increased from 2003 to 2023. The direction of the trend line changed in 2007. There was a decrease from 2003 to 2007. There was an increase from 2007 to 2023. Any indicated increase or decrease is statistically significant.

[Based on linear and quadratic trend analyses using logistic regression models controlling for sex, race/ethnicity, and grade ($p < 0.05$). Significant linear trends (if present) across all available years are described first followed by linear changes in each segment of significant quadratic trends (if present).]
