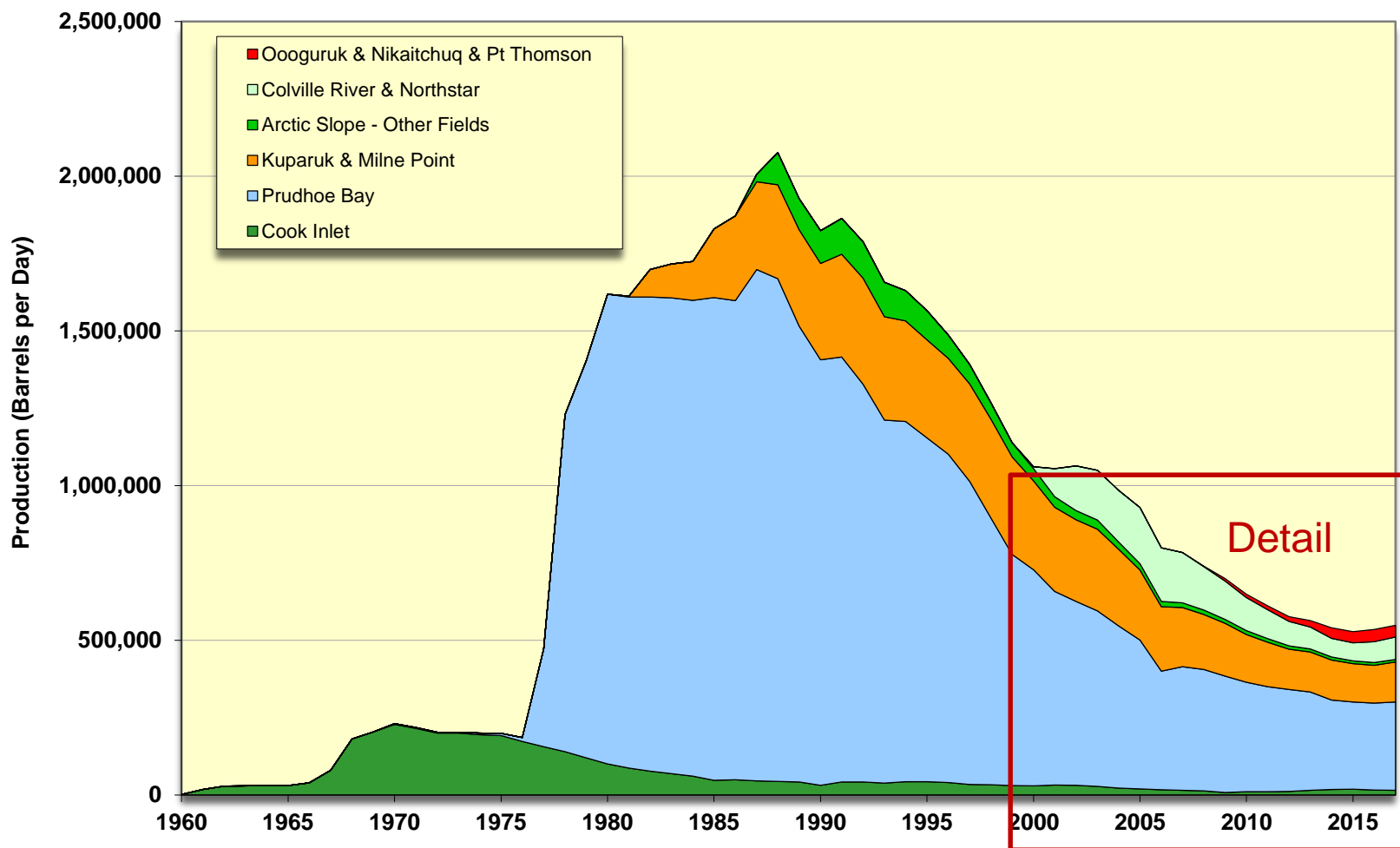

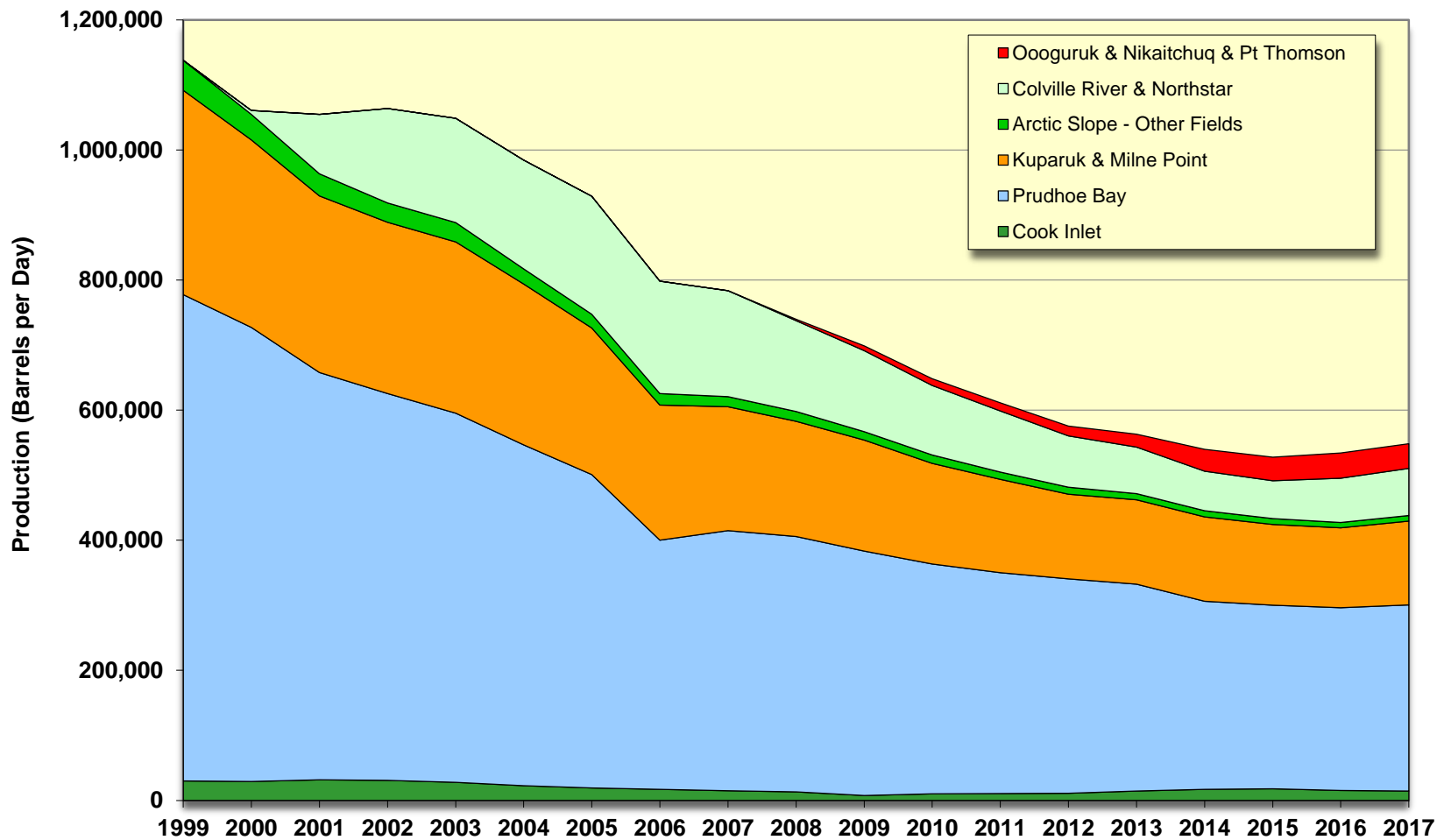

Alaska's Average Daily Oil & NGL Production Rate 1960 - 2017



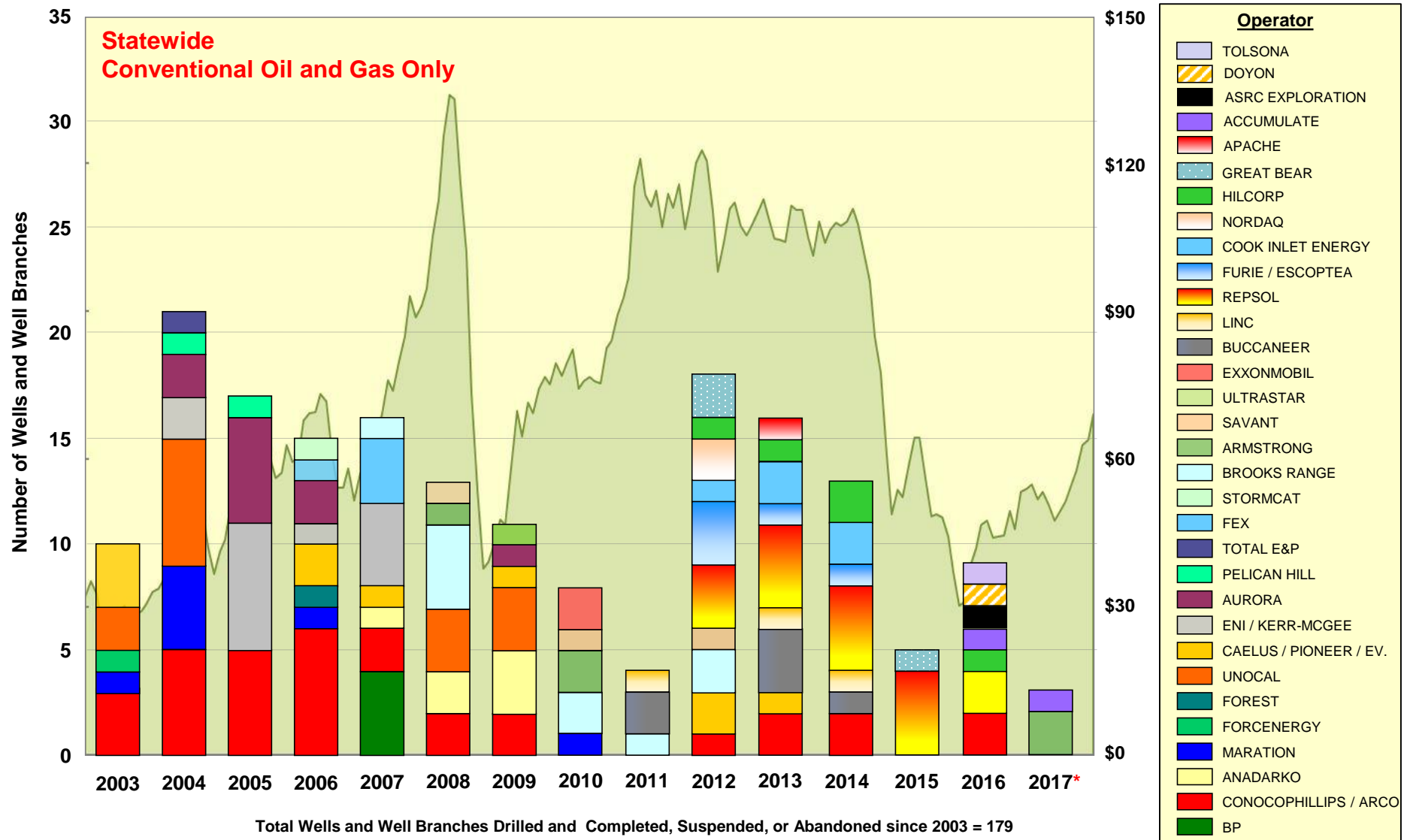
Alaska's Average Daily Oil & NGL Production Rate 1999 - 2017

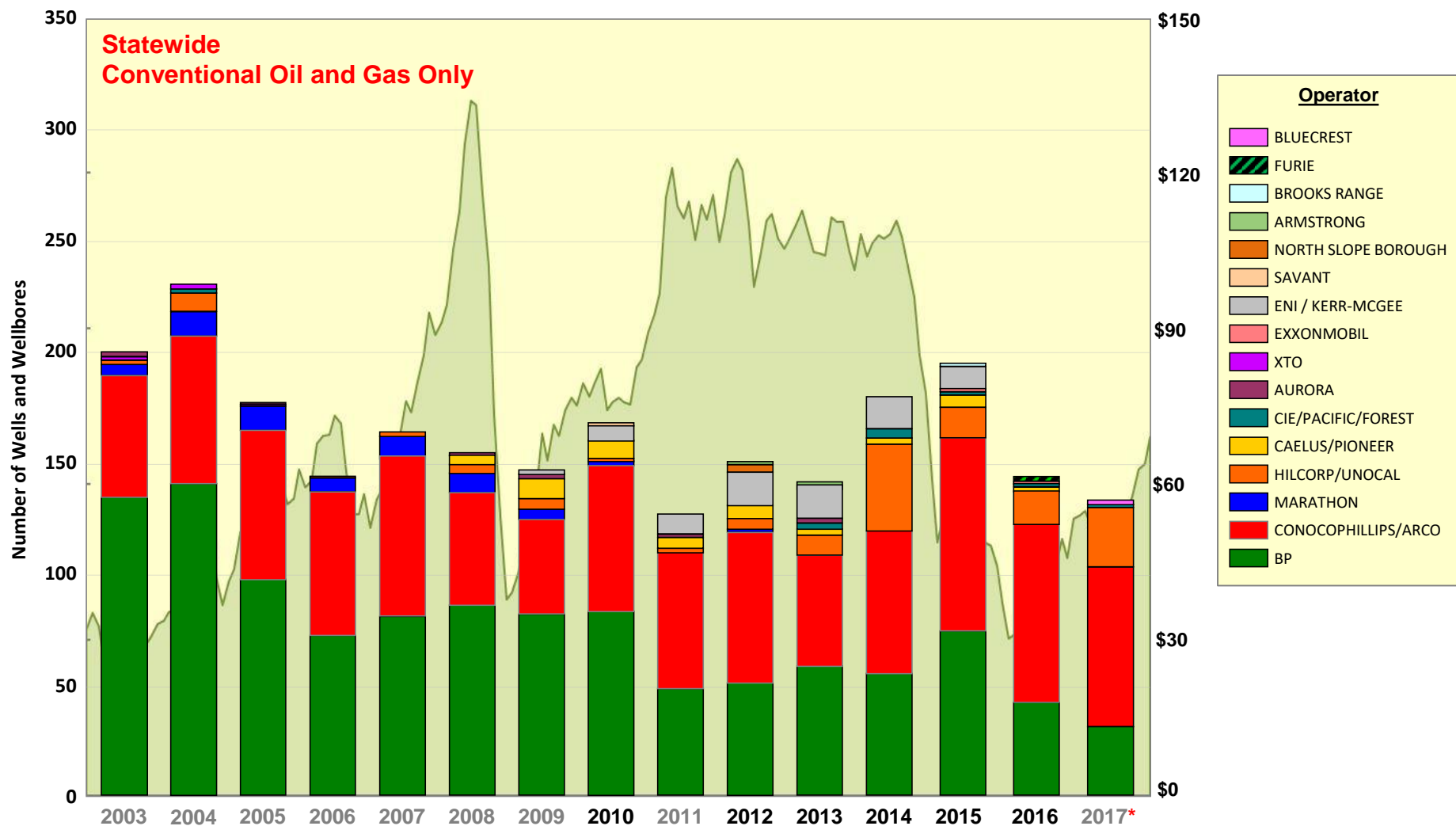
Background: West Coast Monthly Average Spot Price for Alaska North Slope Crude Oil (Dollars per Barrel)

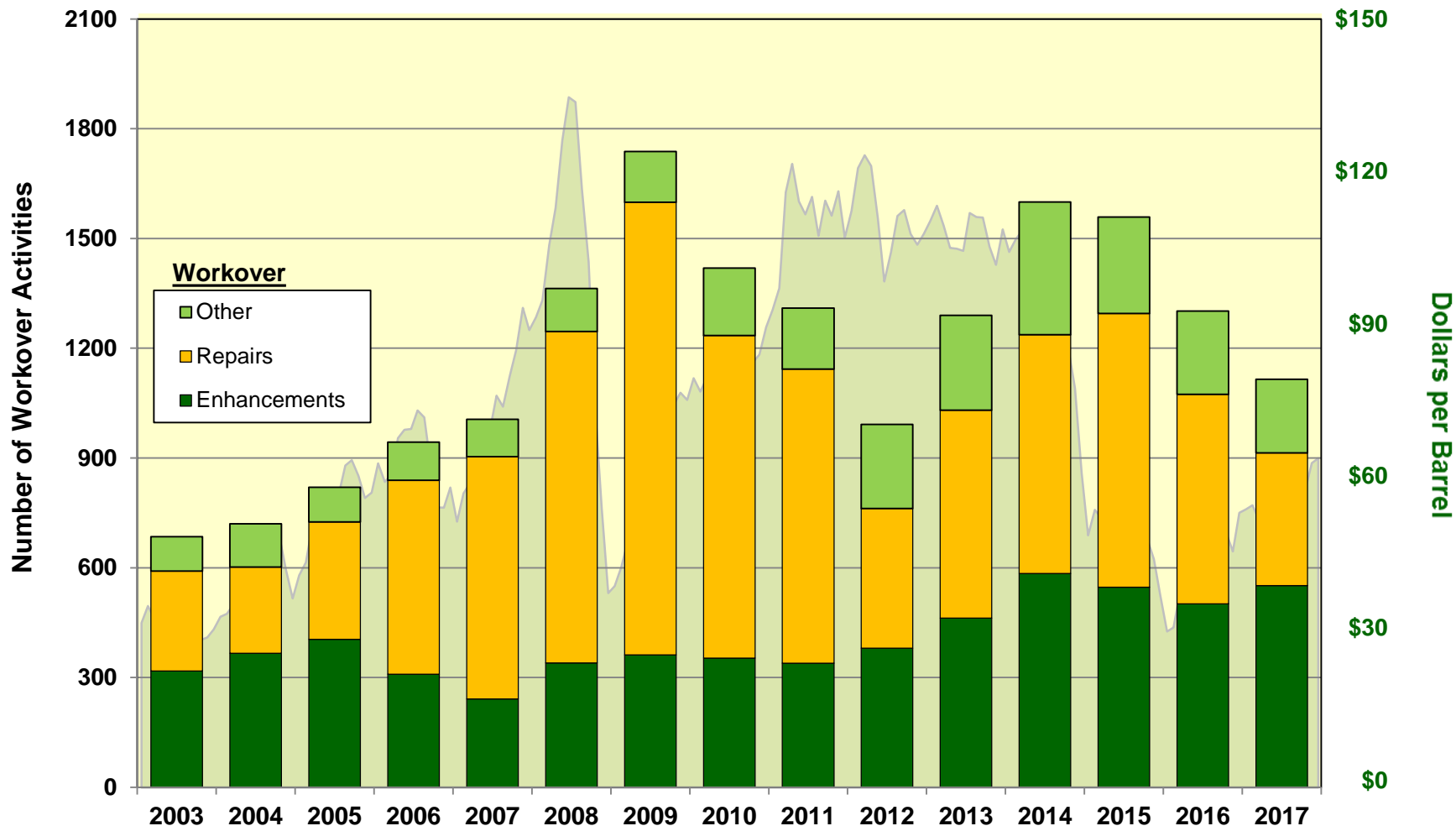
Total Wells and Well Branches Drilled then Completed, Suspended or Abandoned During 2017 = 133**

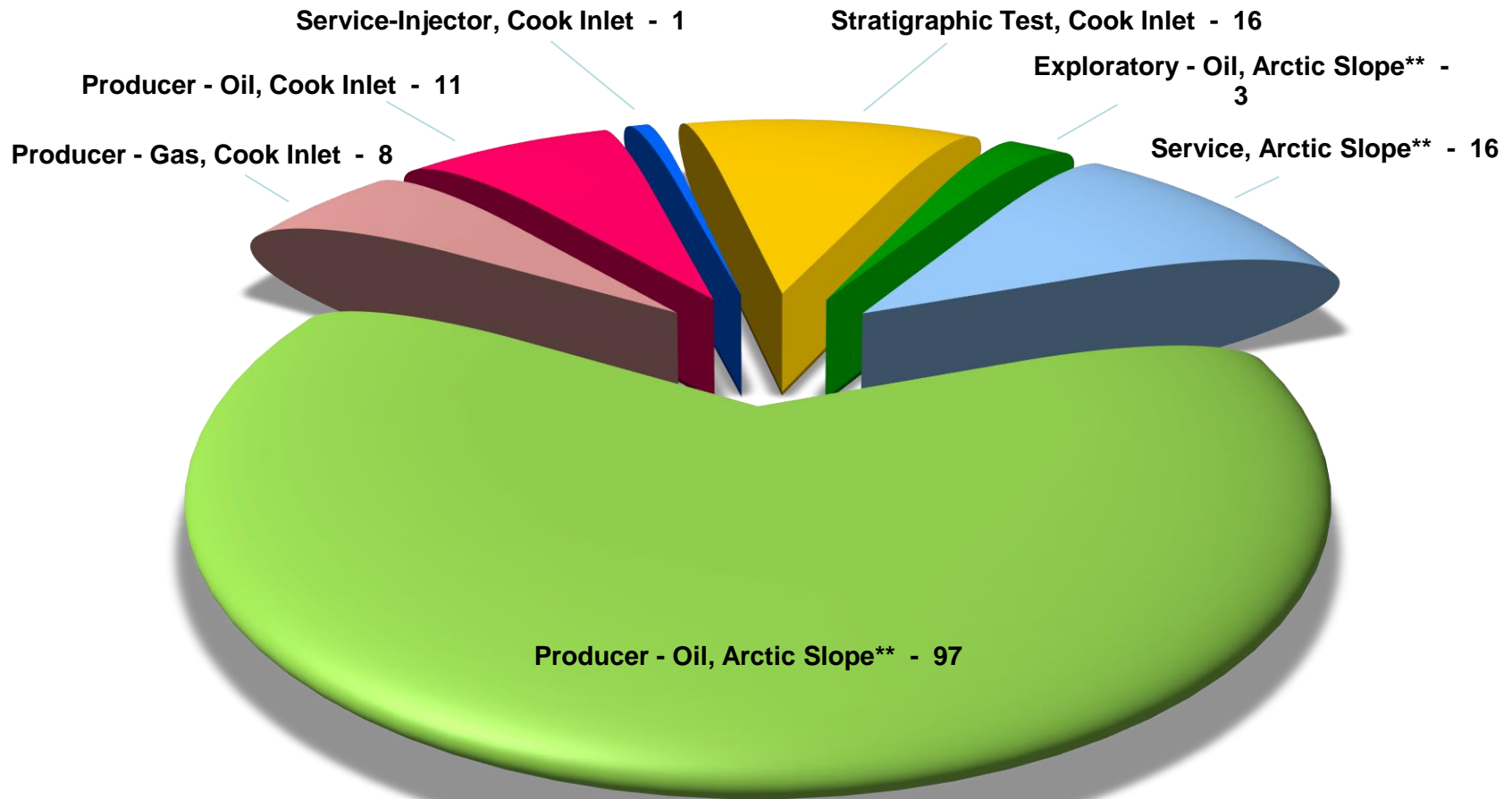
Background: West Coast Monthly Average Spot Price for Alaska North Slope Crude Oil (Dollars per Barrel)

Alaska 2017: Drilled Wells and Well Branches

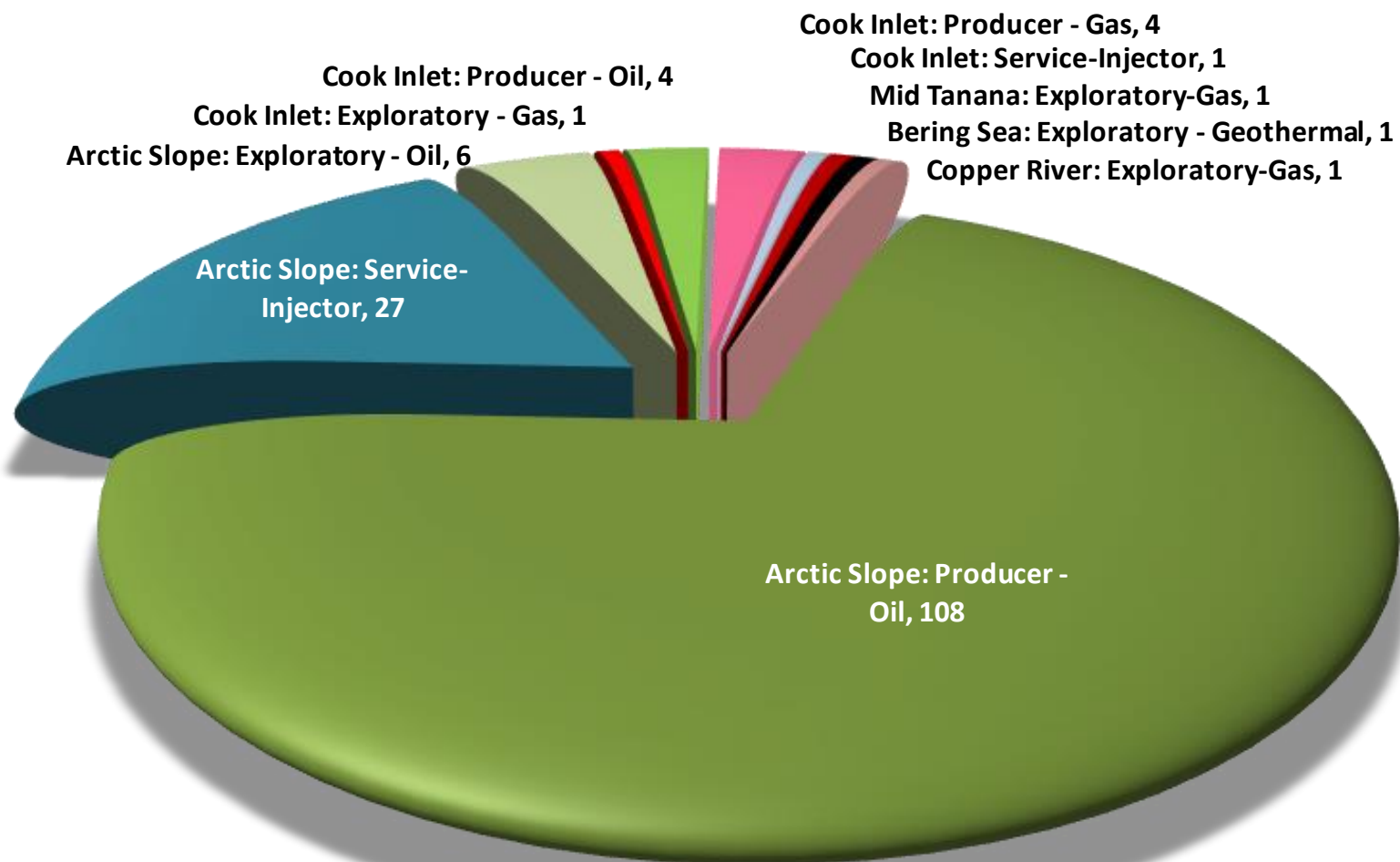
