BILL NO. SB 259

Analysis

Senate Bill 259 would provide salary increases to the salaries listed in Alaska Statute (AS) 39.27.011(a). The salaries would be updated accordingly by the Department of Administration, Division of Personnel and Labor Relations, in line with the salary increases provided to the supervisory bargaining unit under AS 23.40.215. The supervisory bargaining unit received a one percent increase for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024.

The reenactment of AS 39.27.011(m) has an effective date of July 1, 2024 (FY2025).
