* Sec. 4. FEDERAL AND OTHER PROGRAM RECEIPTS. Federal receipts, designated program receipts under AS 37.05.146(b)(3), information services fund program receipts under AS 44.21.045(b), Exxon Valdez oil spill trust receipts under AS 37.05.146(b)(4), receipts of the Alaska Housing Finance Corporation, receipts of the Alaska marine highway system fund under AS 19.65.060(a), receipts of the vaccine assessment fund under AS 18.09.230, receipts of the University of Alaska under AS 37.05.146(b)(2), receipts of the highways equipment working capital fund under AS 44.68.210, and receipts of commercial fisheries test fishing operations under AS 37.05.146(c)(20) that are received during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, and that exceed the amounts appropriated by this Act are appropriated conditioned on compliance with the program review provisions of AS 37.07.080(h). Receipts received under this section during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, do not include the balance of a state fund on June 30, 2025.

* Sec. 5. INSURANCE CLAIMS. The amounts to be received in settlement of insurance claims for losses and the amounts to be received as recovery for losses are appropriated from the general fund to the

(1) state insurance catastrophe reserve account (AS 37.05.289(a)); or

(2) appropriate state agency to mitigate the loss.

* Sec. 6. NATIONAL PETROLEUM RESERVE - ALASKA IMPACT GRANT PROGRAM. The amount received by the National Petroleum Reserve - Alaska special revenue fund (AS 37.05.530(a)) under 42 U.S.C. 6506a(*l*) or former 42 U.S.C. 6508 by June 30, 2025, estimated to be \$29,500,000, is appropriated from that fund to the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for capital project grants under the National Petroleum Reserve - Alaska impact grant program.

* Sec. 7. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. Tax credits available from the federal government for certain renewable energy projects funded by the Alaska Energy Authority, estimated to be \$0, are appropriated to the Alaska Energy Authority for continued funding of renewable energy projects or matching funds for federal grants.

* Sec. 8. DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME. The proceeds from the sale of stateowned vessels and aircraft received by the Department of Fish and Game during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2026, estimated to be \$150,000, are appropriated to the Department of 1

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Fish and Game for renewal, replacement, and maintenance of vessels and aircraft.

* Sec. 9. LAPSE (a) The appropriations made in secs. 1, 5(2), and 6 - 8 of this Act are for capital projects and lapse under AS 37.25.020.

(b) The appropriation made in sec. 5(1) of this Act is for the capitalization of a fund and does not lapse.

* Sec. 10. This Act takes effect July 1, 2025.
