Explanation

The former Solid Waste Services Administration building at 1111 E 56th Ave. has been identified and used as an emergency cold weather shelter in Anchorage this year. The current operating costs of the shelter are estimated to be \$3.94 million for the total cost between Oct 15th - April 30th. Winter funding is covered by the Municipality.

2024 Session Operating Budget Amendment

The shelter is able to be used as a low-barrier shelter between May 1 -Oct 15th. The cost for summer operations is \$3.6 million.

The Anchorage Assembly and Mayor have jointly requested (Anchorage Resolution 2023-37) a \$4 million match from the Alaska Legislature to keep the shelter open year-round. This request is also the priority for the entire Anchorage Delegation.
