Page 1, following line 11:

Insert a new subsection to read:

"(c) Not later than 30 days after the beginning of the first regular session of each legislature, the commissioner shall prepare a report identifying water bodies, or portions of water bodies, in the state that the department determines are qualified for designation as outstanding national resource water under federal law. The commissioner shall transmit the report to the senate secretary and the chief clerk of the house of representatives and notify the legislature that the report is available. For each water body, or portion thereof, that the department determines is qualified for designation, the report must also provide whether

(1) the water is habitat for fish or other wildlife;

(2) the water has recreational value;

(3) the water contains endangered fish or other endangered wildlife;

(4) any portion of the water is in or adjacent to a park, monument, refuge, fish and game critical habitat area, or other protected area;

(5) the water provides value or is necessary to public infrastructure or commercial ventures;

(6) the water is of exceptional significance or interest, regardless of whether the water is considered high quality;

(7) the water is of significant archaeological, cultural, or scientific importance;

(8) the water provides special educational opportunities;

(9) the water contains unique aquatic habitat."
