Analysis

This bill allows individuals aged 18 through 20 to sell, serve, deliver, or dispense alcoholic beverages on certain licensed premises and removes supervision of individuals aged 18 through 20.

If this legislation is adopted, the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office will need to update the online licensing and case management systems and updating regulations. These changes will be incorporated into planned system updates and regulations packages. The Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
