This version also does not set pharmacy dispensing fees, restrict exclusive home delivery or specialty pharmacy arrangements, require use of National Average Drug Acquisition Cost (NADAC) for drug pricing or increase administration costs by prohibiting spread pricing.

HB226 has been amended by removing any provisions that applied to the health and pharmacy self-insured benefit plans (Alaskacare employee and retiree plans) administered by the Division of Retirement & Benefits. Accordingly, the division submits a zero fiscal note.
