FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS**STATE OF ALASKA
2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION****Analysis**

This bill directs the Department of Education and Early Development to establish a centralized program for deaf and hard of hearing students. This program can be operated by a school district who has outlined a program that supports state and federal laws pertaining to special education. Plans must indicate how the school district will support a student's individual education plan and provides any accommodations needed for the student.

This bill focuses on providing the best for instructional support for students in the method of communication that is the best fit for the child, including American Sign Language.

This fiscal note includes a one-time cost of \$6.0 for legal fees to implement the necessary regulation changes.
