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FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

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Analysis

HCR 1 establishes a joint legislative task force on sport fishing service providers in Southeast Alaska. This task force consists of two legislative members and ten non-legislative members for a total of twelve task force members. This fiscal note is based on the following assumptions:

- -Task force members, with the possible exception of the Board of Fisheries member, will be selected from the southeast region of Alaska.
- -The task force will meet in-person three times during the interim between the first and second session of the Thirty-Fourth Legislature.
- -Task force meetings will take place in Southeast Alaska locations, most likely Juneau, Ketchikan, and Sitka; it is the sponsor's intent that the meetings will be held at legislative facilities in these locations.
- -It is the sponsor's intent that one current legislative aide of a legislative task force member will be sufficient to support the work of the task force.
- -Legislative Affairs Agency support for task force meetings is not expected to require additional resources.
- -All task force members are entitled to per diem and travel expenses.
- -The Board of Fisheries member may not be from Southeast Alaska and receives an honorarium to attend all meetings (both virtual and in-person) per AS 16.05.290; therefore, the expenses for this member are calculated separately.

Travel Expense Assumptions for All Other Task Force Members

Legislative members, per Legislative Council policy, receive per diem calculated at the federal per diem rate; public members are calculated at the State of Alaska per diem rate per AS 39.20.18.

The airfare rate used in the fiscal note calculation is based on an average of roundtrip airfare rates between Southeast communities on Alaska Airlines as of March 12, 2025.

Lodging expenses are based on the Department of Defense per diem lodging rate for Juneau and Ketchikan; and finally, estimates assume that one or more members will not be required to travel for at least one meeting. Lodging reimbursement will be based on actual receipted lodging expenses.
