- Permanent resident of Alaska
- Submits a completed application and a letter of support from their tribe

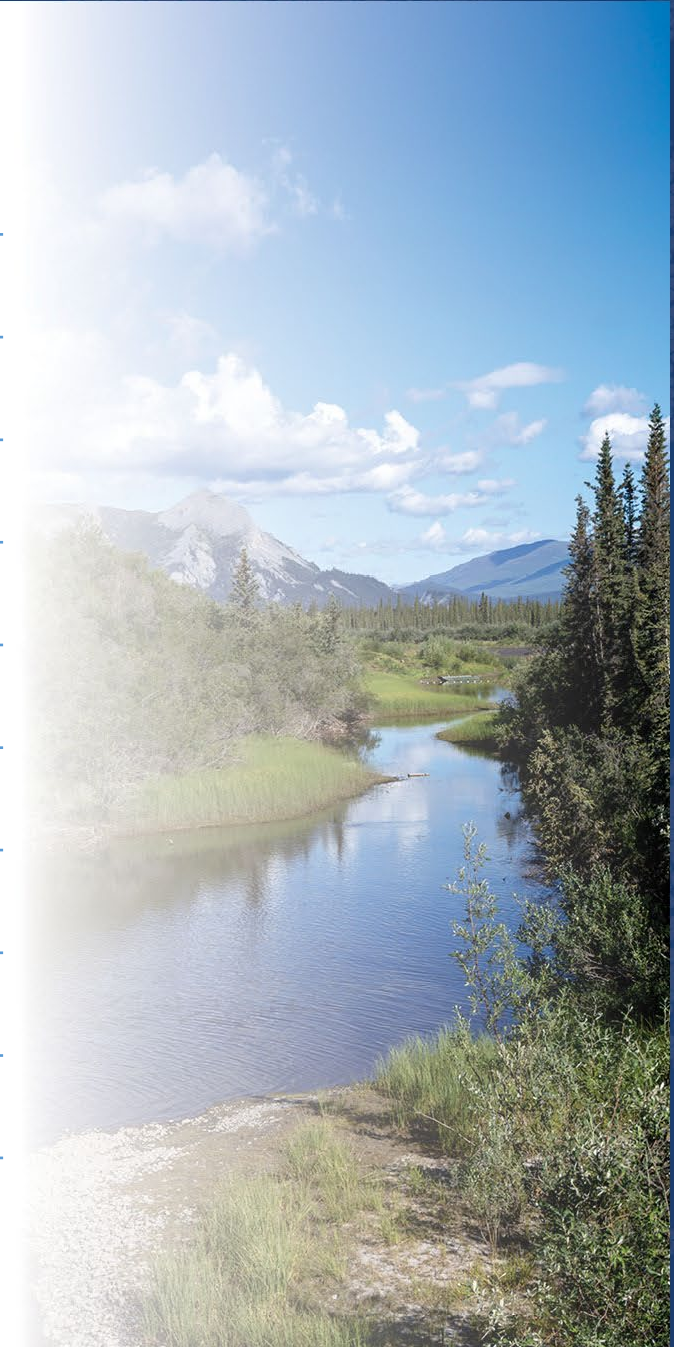
