Analysis

This bill increases the annual employer contribution rate by requiring an additional employer contribution amount to be calculated at the rate certified under AS 37.10.220(a)(8) for both the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) and the Teachers' Retirement System (TRS). This bill will cause employers who participate in the PERS and TRS retirement plans to pay more towards liquidating past service liability of the plans. This bill will take effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c)
