FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill amends sections of statute related to municipal governments and to the State of Alaska procurement code to implement a procurement preference on agriculture and fisheries products that applies to municipalities that receive State money, school districts that receive State money, and to State of Alaska agencies. For municipalities that receive State money, the procurement preference requires Alaska-produced agricultural and seafood products be purchased if their price is up to 10 percent more than an out-of-state product, as long as the product is not more than 25 percent above the price of the out-of-state product. This is an increase from the current limits of 7 percent and 15 percent, respectively. For State of Alaska agencies and school districts that receive State money, a procurement preference of between 10 percent and 25 percent - for procurement consideration purposes only - must be applied when reviewing quotes or proposals. This is an increase from the current preference of 7 percent and 15 percent, respectively, which increases the likelihood that Alaska-produced items will be purchased by State of Alaska agencies and school districts that receive State money. The Division of Community and Regional Affairs does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation and, therefore, submits a zero fiscal note.
