HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 3

"Establishing the Joint Legislative Task Force on Artificial Intelligence."

EXPLANATION OF CHANGES

Version A to Version G

In the House Community and Regional Affairs Committee Substitute additions were made to the HCR 3, to highlight the use of generated images as part of artificial intelligence and to further explain the different ways artificial intelligence can be used. In addition, changes were made to reduce the fiscal note.

Changes

Page 1, line 12: "and generated images" was added after "artificial intelligence"

Page 1, line 14: "and abuse" was added after "bias."

Page 2, line 2: A new whereas was added: "WHEREAS artificial intelligence includes a diverse and growing set of tools and technology, including expert systems, machine learning, generative agents, new hardware platforms and software systems."

Page 2, line 9: A new further resolved was added: "(1) Create a set of common terms and definitions as a foundation of the task force work and future legislation;" and the remaining sections were renumbered.

Page 2, line 11: ", and costs" was added following "applications."

Page 2, line 13: "efficiency, productivity improvements and staffing vacancies" was added following "decision-making processes"

Page 2, line 16: "entrepreneurship and new venture creation" was added following "including."

Page 2, line 25: "and recommended budgets" was added following "plan"

Page 2, line 19: "including the use of generated images" was added after "intelligence use"

Page 3, line 9, Version A: "(6) members of the task force are entitled to the members normal rates of per diem and travel; and be it" was deleted.

Page 3, line 9: "vendors" was inserted following "regions"

Page 3, line 12: (4) was reworded to say: "the task force shall meet at the call of the chair and, to the extent practicable, conduct meetings virtually or through other electronic means"
