FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 31

Analysis

This bill exempts from numbering and registration commercial fishing vessels that are licensed under AS 16.05.490 or 16.05.530.

Using calendar year (CY) 2023 CFEC commercial vessels data, there are an estimated total of 4,750 vessels that would qualify for this exemption. The DMV charges \$24.00 per 3-year boat registration, so we anticipate a reduction in annual revenue by \$38.0.

This bill repeals AS 30.30.095, 30.30.096; and AS 37.05.146(c)(79), dissolving the Derelict Vessel Prevention Program Fund (DVPPF). The DMV has previously been required to transfer boat titling revenues to the DVPPF. This estimated annual transfer is approximately \$38.0.
