FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill increases the regional per student monthly stipend amounts for residential school operations under AS 14.16.200(b) by 50 percent as follows (noted in whole dollars): -Southeast Region (Region I) increases from \$1,230 to \$1,845 -Southcentral Region (Region II) increases from \$1,200 to \$1,800 -Interior Region (Region III) increases from \$1,452 to \$2,178 -Southwest Region (Region IV) increases from \$1,509 to \$2,264 -Northern Remote Region (Region V) increases from \$1,776 to \$2,664 The current projected FY2026 residential school funding is estimated to be \$8,458.1 (noted in thousands). The bill increases this projected funding to \$12,494.0, resulting in a \$4,035.9 projected increase in funding to school districts operating residential programs. This portion of the bill takes effect July 1, 2025 (FY2026).

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
