STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

The bill enhances procurement preferences for the state, municipalities, and school districts for agricultural and fisheries products harvested or processed within Alaska. It raises the percentage above similar outside products where the state or municipality shall purchase Alaska-produced products from 7% to 10% and raises the percentage above where the state or municipality may purchase Alaska-produced products from 15% to 25%.
