22 services to protect the child are not required, and (3) identifies an appropriate
23 community-based family services entity that actively reaches out to families to provide

1 support services, the department or local government health or social services agency
2 shall seek the written consent of the child's parent or guardian to refer the family to the
3 community-based family services entity. If the parent or guardian consents to the
4 referral, the department or local government health or social services agency shall
5 refer the parent or guardian to the community-based family services entity identified
6 by the department. If the child has more than one parent or guardian and only one
7 parent or guardian consents to the referral, the department or local government health
8 or social services agency shall refer the parent or guardian who consents to the local
9 community-based family services entity but may not provide information to the local
10 community-based family services entity concerning the parent or guardian who does
11 not consent to the referral. A community-based family services entity that receives
12 information from the department or a local government health or social services
13 agency under this subsection may not disclose the information to a person who is not
14 authorized by law to receive it."
