FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 383

Analysis

Currently the Division of Economic Development (DED) utilizes Vehicle Rental Tax Receipts for implementation of the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy priority of growing Alaska's visitor industry, for contract administration for tourism research and for other division activities.

HB 383 directs Vehicle Rental Tax Receipts to the general fund or to a new Alaska Tourism Marketing Fund. To maintain current levels of operational service in DED, a fund source change from Vehicle Rental Tax Receipts to General Fund (UGF) would be required.
