Analysis

SB 9 amends Children in Need of Aid (CINA) statute 47.10.013(c) (Abandonment – Safe Surrender) by adding an infant safety device as a method for surrendering an infant. The amendment includes requirements of an infant safety device, defines the department's authority to implement and train those who employ the use of the device, and defines a designated facility for housing a device.

The department would require a new Social Services Program Coordinator whose function would be to oversee regulation development, certification, and recertification of devices installed under this bill.

Total Costs

\$132.5 in personnel costs (personal services)\$3.5 in position IT equipment and additional office supplies (one-time cost)

SB 9 requires the Department of Family and Community Services to promulgate regulations that prescribe which facilities can house an infant safety device. Due to the need for overseeing multiple facilities, certification of devices, and recertification for devices, the addition of a Social Services Program Coordinator (Range 20 A) at \$132.5 with \$3.5 in initial IT and equipment costs is necessary.

The amount of travel necessary is unknown, however, the Department anticipates this to be a significant need should multiple locations throughout the State request this device to be installed.
