Senate Bill 126 Sectional Analysis

Section 1: Adds a new exemption for athletic team physicians to AS 08.64.370, which lists circumstances where a person can practice medicine in our state without being licensed by the State Medical Board. To qualify for this new exemption, the physician must be licensed to practice medicine in another state, under a written agreement with an athletic team from that state, and only provide services to members of the team while traveling to/from or participating in a sports event in Alaska.

Section 2: Adds a reference to this new exemption to AS 14.30.142(d), which defines “qualified person” for the purposes of evaluating a student athlete who has been removed from a sporting event or practice for suspicion of concussion.
