





Q1: Our current crime wave is one of the most serious issues I am concerned about today.




Q2: I have changed things about my regular routine because I am worried about the possibility of crime.




Q3: I believe the Legislature could do more to protect us from crime.




Q4: I believe that Senate Bill 54, passed last year, did enough to protect Alaskans from criminals.
