BILL NO. SB 47

Analysis

Senate Bill 47 proposes updates to the management responsibilities of Chugach State Park, allowing for greater flexibility in land management and infrastructure improvements.

This bill allows the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to grant easements or rights-of-way in Chugach State Park to municipalities if such actions improve public access or are in the public interest. This authority solves an issue allowing municipalities to bond for improvements inside of a legislatively designated state park.

This bill will improve infrastructure and encourage tourism, benefiting businesses such as tour operators, outdoor outfitters, and local retailers. This bill has the potential to allow for more commercial use of park land due to improved access and safety to trailheads within Chugach State Park.

The bill cost reflects DNR administrative costs for easement adjudication, and the applicant will be billed for title, easement and survey work.
