#### **BUDGET ACTIONS:**

In recognition of the constraints on currently available revenue, the Senate Finance Subcommittee denied the requests for General Fund increments. The Subcommittee made no additions to the Governor's Amended budget request.

#### **Judiciary Amended Budget Request:**

The Senate Finance Subcommittee accepted the following items requested in the Governor's Amended budget. These items include:

- \$200.0 Interagency receipt authority for one position
- \$10,586.3 American Rescue Plan Act funds replaced with general funds
- All requested expenditures of Mental Health (MH) and Mental Health Trust Authority Authorized Receipts (MHTAAR) for a centralized therapeutic courts calendar and funding for 2 paralegals.
