#### BILL NO. SB 140

#### Analysis

SB 140 creates a new section in AS 29.60 and establishes a fire station grant program in the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development, as well as a fire station grant fund. The fire station grant fund would require a new fund code to be created.

The program will be a matching grant program available to persons in charge of construction or renovation of an eligible fire station. Each fiscal year, the department shall use at least 50 percent of the balance in the fire station grant fund on June 30 of the preceding fiscal year for fire station construction and renovation matching grants.

If this legislation passes, the Division of Community and Regional Affairs will administer the grant program with existing resources.
