#### A BILL

#### FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act making certain veterans eligible for a lifetime permit to access state park campsites and the parking and restrooms of developed facilities without charge; and providing for an effective date."

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 41.21.026(d) is amended to read:

(d) The department shall issue free of charge to <u>a</u> disabled <u>veteran</u>
[VETERANS] of this country <u>a</u> [AN ANNUAL] state park <u>developed facility</u>
<u>parking and restroom and</u> developed campsite permit <u>that is valid for the life of</u>
<u>the permit holder</u>. The permit shall allow <u>the</u> [A] disabled veteran to use a state park
developed campsite <u>and the parking and restrooms of a developed facility</u> for
personal recreation use without a charge or fee under (a)(2) <u>or (10)</u> of this section.
<u>The department shall automatically renew a permit issued under this subsection</u>
<u>every five vears upon receiving confirmation of the permit holder's mailing</u>
<u>address.</u> While utilizing a developed campsite <u>or the parking or restrooms of a</u>

developed facility without charge under this subsection, the disabled veteran shall 2 comply with all other statutes or regulations pertaining to the use of the developed 3 campsite or facility. The department shall provide a form for use by a disabled veteran when applying for a permit under this section. Not later than February 1 of each year, the department shall prepare a report on the number of permits issued to disabled veterans under this subsection during the previous calendar year and notify the 6 legislature that the report is available.

\* Sec. 2. AS 41.21.026 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

In this section, "disabled veteran" means a disabled person whose (g) disability was incurred or aggravated

- (1) in the line of duty in the military service of the United States; or
- (2) while serving in the Alaska Territorial Guard.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
