FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB103

Analysis

SB 103 adds a new subsection to the certified nurse aide section of law (AS 08.68.331) that outlines what a Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) training program must include and that it must be conducted in a manner to ensure the clients receive safe and competent care. Currently, AS 08.68.331(a)(1) allows the Board of Nursing to, after consultation with affected agencies, adopt regulations regarding the certification of nurse aides including the training, education, and other qualifications for certification that will ensure that the nurse aides are competent to perform the tasks of their occupation. Regulations have been adopted by the board that ensure the training programs are conducted in a safe manner and that clients receive safe and competent care.

If the bill passes the following expenses will be incurred, but the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing will absorb the cost.

Services: \$1.4 in FY2026 for legal costs for regulations project to conform with statutory changes.

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services (fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF)). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065. The total amount of revenue collected approximately equals each occupation's actual regulatory costs.
