BILL NO. HB 307

Analysis

This bill amends AS 33.30.015(a) relating to living conditions for prisoners by removing the restriction prohibiting a prisoner from possessing a computer in the prisoner's cell, and expanding the approved purposes for which a prisoner may use a computer to include facilitation of rehabilitation and reintegration, access to legal reference materials, visitation, or as part of a reentry plan.

Passage of this bill will allow prisoners within a Department of Corrections (DOC) facility to use current technology to assist with and support their rehabilitation and successful reentry with no anticipated fiscal impact to the DOC. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
