Analysis

HB 31 would exempt certain qualifying vessels from state registration and numbering.

Proceeds from the sale of a vessel under this chapter shall be applied in a specific order including impound costs, towing, handling or storage, administrative costs, liens, and in the event an owner is not found and deposited into the general fund instead of the derelict vessel prevention program fund.

The Division of Community and Regional Affairs does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.
