### A BILL

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to notice of new fees and fee increases from the University of Alaska; 2 relating to billing statements from the University of Alaska; and providing for an 3 effective date." 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: 5 \* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read: 6 7 SHORT TITLE. This Act may be known as the Student Fee Transparency Act. \* Sec. 2. AS 14.40.170 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 8 9 (c) At least 30 days before the Board of Regents imposes a new fee or 10 increases an existing fee under (b)(3) of this section, the board shall provide, by 11 electronic mail, to all currently enrolled students a notice that specifies

(1) the amount of the new fee or fee increase;

(2) the reason for the new fee or fee increase and the purpose for which

the university will use the revenue generated by the new fee or fee increase; and
