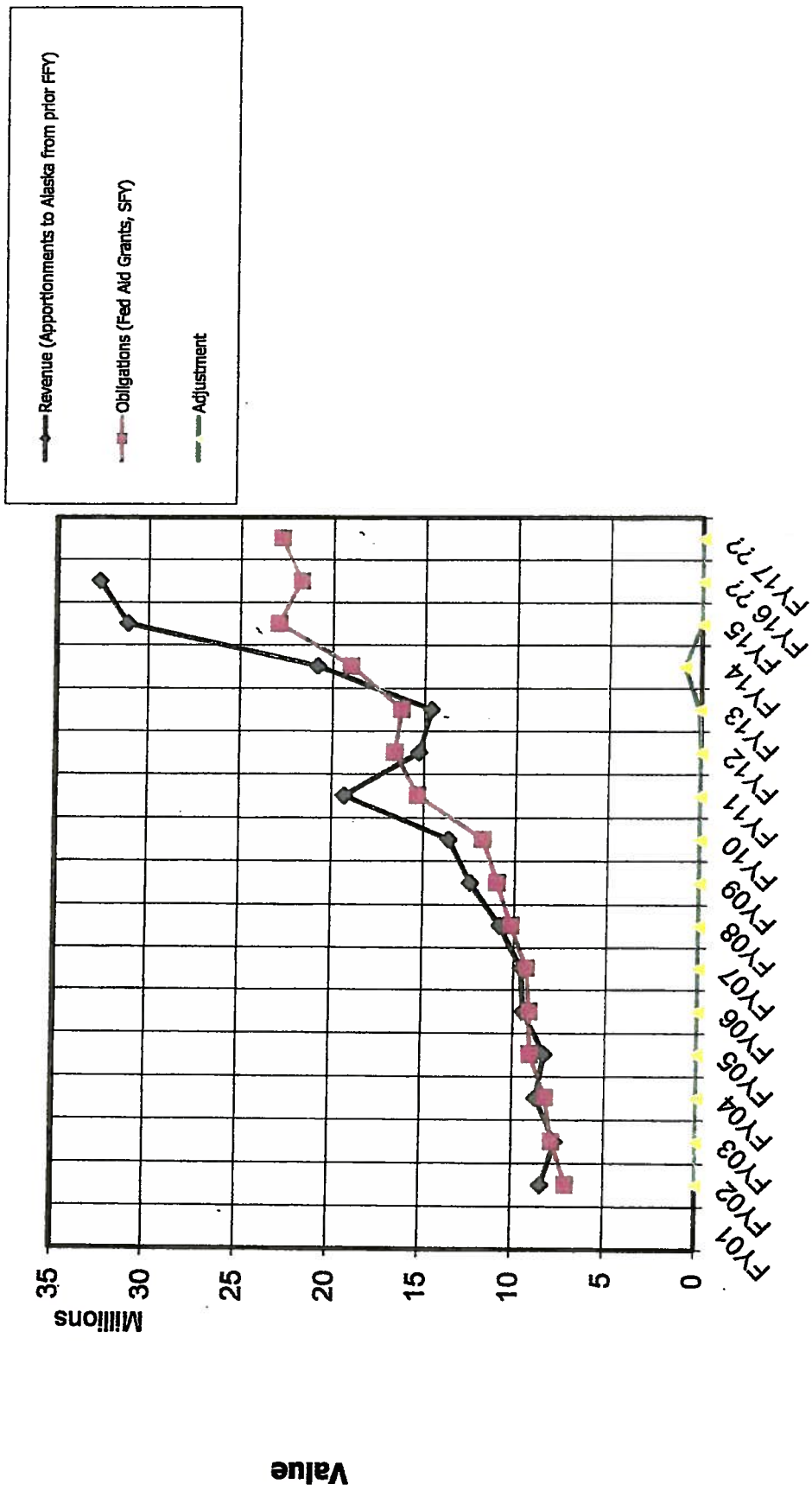

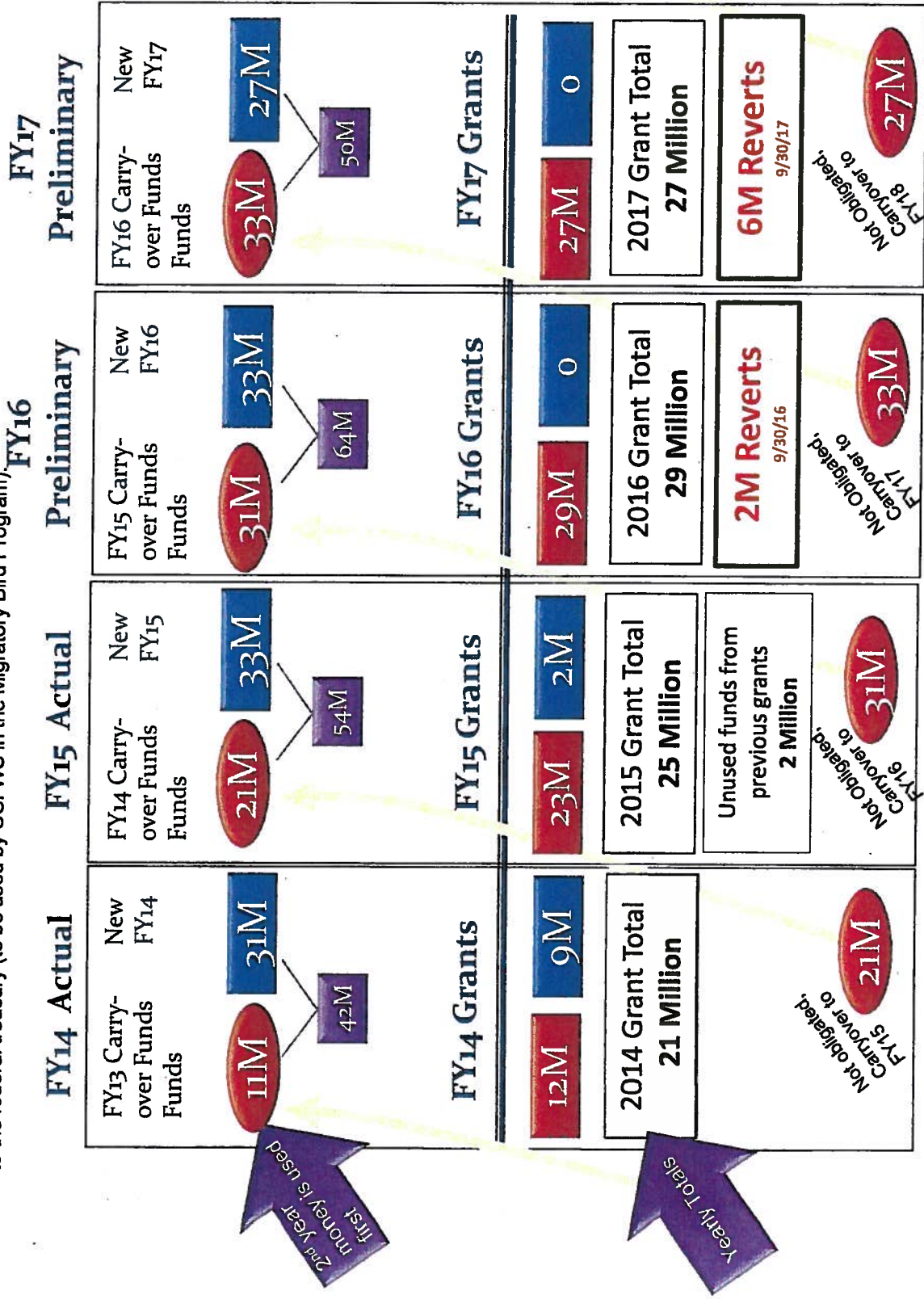

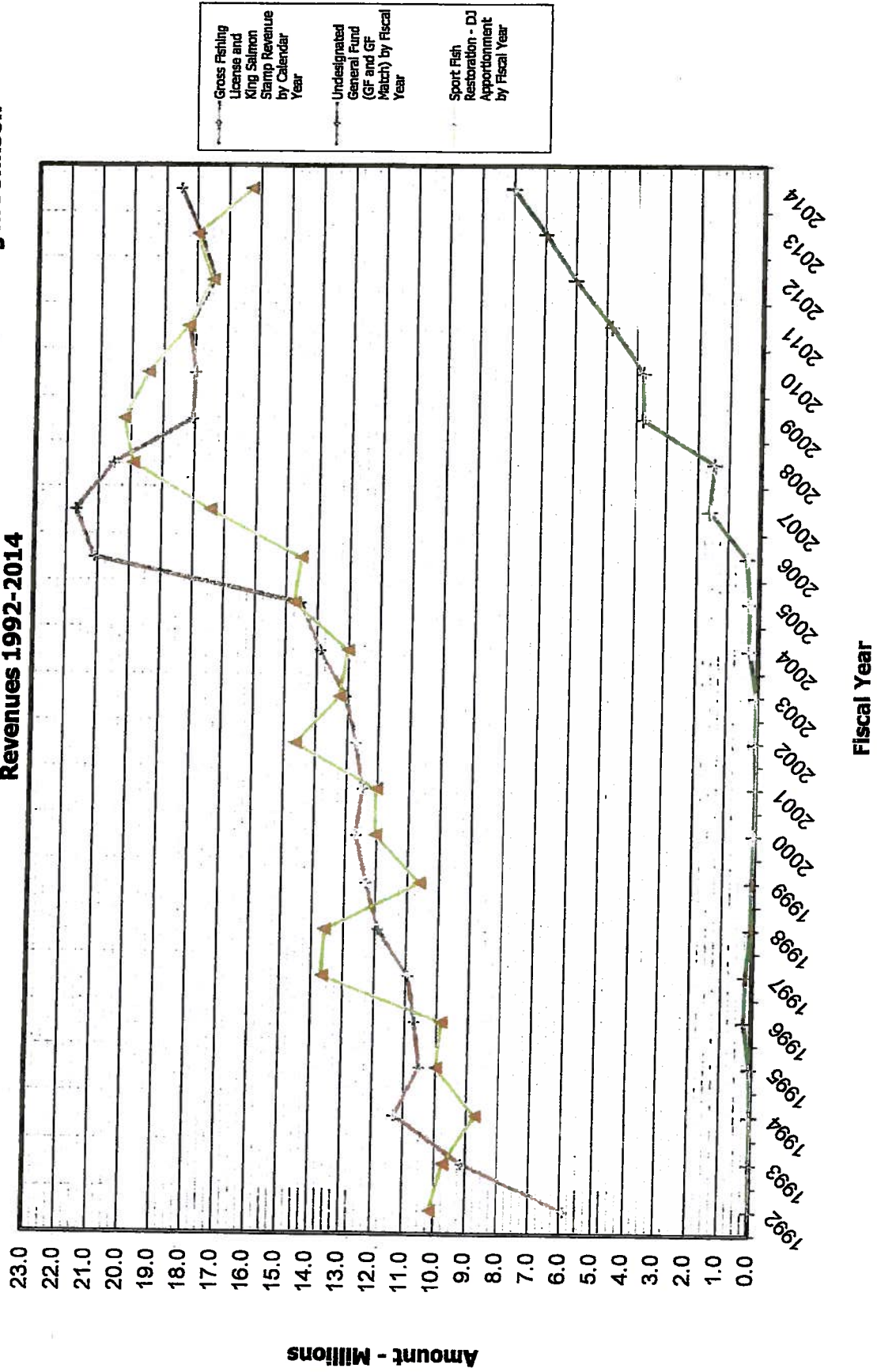


Pitmann-Robertson Funding to ADF&G

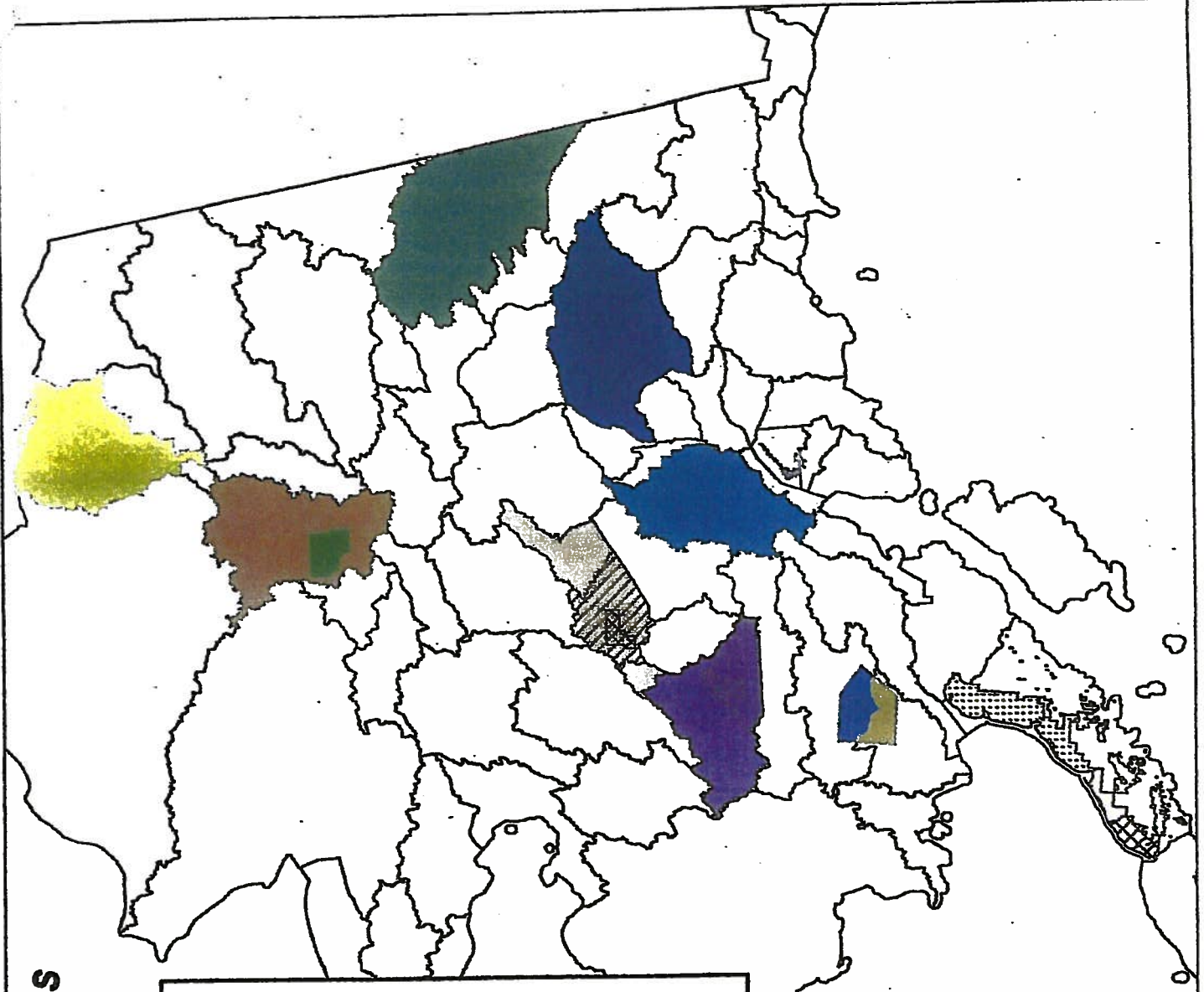
Pitmann-Robertson funding must be obligated through a USFWS grant within 2 years. If funds are not obligated within 2 years, they revert to the federal treasury (to be used by USFWS in the Migratory Bird Program).
