Section 1: amends AS 04.09.320(e) to delete reference to AS 04.09.700.

Section 2: amends AS 04.09.320(g) to allow the holder of a brewery retail license to host up to four live music events or other entertainment performances on premises in a calendar year.

Section 3: amends AS 04.09.330(e) to delete reference to AS 04.09.700.

Section 4: amends AS 04.09.330(g) to allow the holder of a winery retail license to host up to four live music events or other entertainment performances on premises in a calendar year.

Section 5: amends AS 04.09.340(e) to delete reference to AS 04.09.700.

Section 6: amends AS 04.09.340(g) to allow the holder of a distillery retail license to host up to four live music events or other entertainment performances on premises in a calendar year.

Section 7: repeals AS 04.09.700. This section of statute currently authorizes holders of a brewery, winery, or distillery retail license to hold live music or entertainment events on premises, limited to four per calendar year, so long as they have received a live music or entertainment permit.
