A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

**"An Act relating to the terms of office of municipal school board members; and
providing for an effective date."**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

*** Section 1.** AS 14.12.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) The governing body of a municipality may by ordinance alter the terms of
office provided for in this section.

*** Sec. 2.** AS 29.20.300(a) is amended to read:

(a) Each municipal school district has a school board. Except as provided in
(b) or (c) of this section, members of a school board are elected at the regular election
for three-year terms and until their successors take office. Members are elected at
large unless a different method of election has been approved by the voters in a regular
election.

*** Sec. 3.** AS 29.20.300 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(c) The governing body of a municipality may by ordinance approved by the

- 1 voters alter the terms of office provided for in (a) of this section.
- 2 * **Sec. 4.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
