Sectional Analysis

Senate Bill 140

Section 1: Adds a new Article 6A to AS 29.60 creating the Fire Station Grant Program.

Sec. 29.60.750 Creates the Fire Station Grant Program as a matching grant program within the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development. Allows grants for up to 50 percent of eligible projects to construct or renovate fire stations.

Sec. 29.60.760 Establishes the Fire Station Grant Fund as a separate fund in the department and provides a framework for use of the fund.

Sec. 29.60.770 Instructs the department to adopt regulations necessary to implement the fire station grant program.

Section 2: Establishes an effective date of July 1, 2025.
