## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

#### STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

## **Analysis**

This bill proposes to open the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) Benefit Plan by adding a new benefit tier for peace officers and firefighters.
An actuarial analysis is necessary to determine the overall cost implications to the PERS. Per AS.24.08.036, fiscal notes on bills affecting state retirement systems - Before a bill which would have an effect on the retirement systems of the state is reported to the rules committee, there shall be attached to the bill an analysis of the long-term and short-term costs to the state if the bill is adopted, as well as the impact of the bill on the actuarial soundness of the fund. The analysis is in addition to the fiscal note requirements of <u>AS 24.08.035</u> .
Due to the significant cost to conduct an actuarial analysis, the administration will, as it always has, initiate this analysis with the State's actuary when legislation is heard in the Finance Committee of either body of the Legislature, prior to the bill being reported to the Rules Committee.
Until an actuarial analysis is complete, costs to implement this legislation are unknown; therefore, an indeterminate note is submitted.
