FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill modernizes public notice procedures by eliminating requirements to publish public notices in newspapers, in favor of providing public notice on the Alaska Online Public Notice System, by mail, and by other means as deemed necessary. In some instances, newspaper notice would remain an option at the commissioner's discretion. The changes would utilize the state's existing online system, which is available to Alaskans at no cost. Public notices posted on this system are permanently retained for future reference.
The Division of Mining, Land, and Water spent an estimated \$12.7 in FY2023 and \$8.1 in FY2024 for public notices published in newspapers.
