



Talkeetna Post \$2,404.6 (in thousands)

- 7.6% increase in population since 2010
- More than 2,500 calls for service annually
- 180 road miles between Mat-Su West & Cantwell
- September 2021 to September 2024:
 - 421 vehicle collisions
 - 262 welfare checks
 - 785 reports of illegal drug use





Special Investigators: \$1,075.5 (in thousands)

 Western Alaska, including Northwest Alaska, reported the highest rate of felony sex offense instances with a rate of 326 per 100,000 population

 This rate exceeds Anchorage, which reported a rate in 206.1 per 100,000 population


- 18% of victims are under the age of 10

- \$123.0 Dispatch center contract increases
- \$65.0 Crime scene forensic van (Soldotna)
- \$50.0 Genetic genealogy unidentified human remains
