



Sectional Analysis HB 146 Ver I

“An act prohibiting the disclosure of public employee information.”

Section 1.

Amends AS 23.40.110 (a) to add a reference to 23.40.115 in section 2 of this bill.

Section 2.

Amends AS 23.40 to prohibit the disclosure of:

1. An employee’s home address.
2. An employee’s date of birth.
3. An employee’s home and personal cell phone number.
4. An employee’s personal email address.
5. An employee’s Union membership.
6. An employee’s bargaining unit membership.
7. An employee’s charitable donation history with two exceptions:
 - a) An employee’s donation disclosure is required by law.
 - b) Written copies of disclosures are required upon request.

Section 3.

Amends 40.25.120(a) with a conforming change with the same language from section 2 to the Alaska State statutes on Public Records and Disclosures.

Section 4.

This section states the applicability of the bill, stating that AS 23.40.110, as amended by Section 1 of this Act, applies to covered public employers on or after the effective date of the Act. It also states that AS 23.40.115, as amended by Section 2 of this Act, applies to any collective bargaining agreements entered into on or after the effective date.
