FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB172

Analysis

SB 172 will enact the Occupational Therapy Licensure Compact (“Compact”) in Alaska. It applies to occupational therapists and occupational therapy assistants.

This Compact operates under a structure where there is no difference between a single- or multi-state license. If a licensee wishes to obtain privilege to practice in another Compact-member state, the licensee must apply through the Compact for the privilege in that state, including paying fees set by the Compact and state in which they are applying for the privilege.

If the bill passes, legal costs totaling \$4.1 will be required to amend regulations in the first year. The Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing will utilize existing resources to cover these expenses.

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Per AS 08.01.065, licensing fees for each occupation are set so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation’s actual regulatory costs.
