





## Background Check Program

- Process is required under background check provisions AS 47.05.310 AS 47.05.390.
  - Applies to any individual or entity that is required by statute or regulation to be licensed by Department of Health (DOH).
  - Applies to any induvial or entity that is eligible to receive Medicaid payments, in whole or in part from DOH for the health, safety and welfare of persons served by a program administered by DOH.
- Processed 26,884 background check applications in SFY2022.
- Current processing times: 4-5 business days for provisional clearances, as long as all documentation has been received.
