### **Executive Summary**

- Alaska's workforce is vital to economic growth.
- Shift from DB to DC pensions increased turnover (Doonan, 2023).
- DB pensions improve retention and service quality (NIRS, 2014).
- Restoring DB plans can boost economic stability.

## Economic Impact of DB Plans

- \$3B in lost GDP due to stagnant growth (BEA, 2023).
- Private investment thrives with strong public services (Bartik, 1991).
- DB plans reduce turnover costs by \$76M/year (Ghilarducci, 2024).

### Alaska's Population Decline Puts Pressure On Public Workforce

- Population shrank by 0.57% (Alaska Beacon, 2023).
- Outmigration of teachers & workers is a major factor (DeFeo et al., 2017).
- States with better pensions retain more residents (NIRS, 2014).

## Public Services & Business Growth

- Infrastructure, education, and safety cut business costs (Fisher, 1997).
- Alaska lags in business formation (St. Louis Fed, 2024).
- DB plans support service stability, boosting investment (Glaeser & Saiz, 2000).

#### DB vs. DC Pension Systems

- DB: Predictable benefits, lower costs over time (Naff & Crum, 2000).
- DC: Higher turnover, lower long-term savings (McWhirter, 2023).
- DB reduces recruitment/training costs (Doonan, 2023).

### Cost-Effectiveness of DB Plans

- DB plans yield higher returns (Ghilarducci, 2024).
- DB systems lower administrative costs (NIRS, 2014).
- DB pensions reduce reliance on social services (Finan et al., 2015).

### Policy Recommendations

- Reinstate Reformed Defined Benefit (DB) pensions for public employees.
- Adopt funding safeguards to prevent shortfalls (SB88, 2024).
- Create a *Developmental State* which **improves** public services to **attract** private investment and skilled workers.(Wright, 2024).
