FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill proposes to legalize mobile sports wagering and establish a program that administers, enforces, and collects tax on the activity.
The mobile gaming is limited to wagers originating in the State of Alaska or in a state or jurisdiction approved by the Department of Revenue (Department) if there is a mobile sports gaming agreement with that state or jurisdiction. This bill proposes that the Department administer the tax and regulate the gambling activity.
The Criminal Investigations Unit (CIU) investigates taxpayer fraud and crimes within the tax programs administered by the Department. The proposed legislation creates a new taxpayer program and requires that licensees report irregular betting activity to the Department for investigation and report to the state any facts and circumstances that constitute a violation of state and federal law. The Department is unable to estimate the workload impact to the CIU at this time. It is possible the unit can investigate a limited amount of reports of fraud with existing resources. The Department will have better insight into the workload impacts after this program is established and operating.
