FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the voting procedures of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board;
2 allowing the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to release information contained in the
3 statewide database of alcohol purchases and shipments to the person who purchased the
4 alcohol or to whom the alcohol was shipped; extending the termination date of the
5 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; and providing for an effective date."

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

7 * **Section 1.** AS 04.06.060 is amended to read:

8 **Sec. 04.06.060. Quorum and majority.** Three members of the board
9 constitute a quorum for the conduct of business, except that a majority of the whole
10 membership of the board must approve all applications for new licenses, and all
11 renewals, transfers, suspensions, and revocations of existing licenses. [IF A
12 MAJORITY OF THE BOARD IS PRESENT AND VOTING, THE DIRECTOR,
13 WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT, MAY CAST A TIE-

BREAKING VOTE.]

* **Sec. 2.** AS 04.06.095 is amended to read:

Sec. 04.06.095. Statewide database. The board, after consulting with package store licensees, shall create and maintain a statewide database that contains a monthly record of the alcohol purchased by, and shipped to, a person who resides in a municipality or established village that has restricted the sale of alcoholic beverages under AS 04.11.491(a)(1), (2), or (3) or (b)(1) or (2). Except as otherwise specifically provided in this section, the information contained in the database is confidential and is not subject to inspection or copying under AS 40.25.110 - 40.25.220. Information in the database shall be purged one year after entry unless it is needed for criminal investigation or prosecution. Information in the database is available only to

(1) a package store licensee, agent, or employee to consult before shipping alcohol to a purchaser in a restricted area as provided in AS 04.11.150(g);

(2) a law enforcement officer;

(3) a probation or parole officer; and

(4) the board; **and**

(5) the person who is the subject of the information; the board shall adopt regulations concerning access by a person to information contained in the database of the purchases by, and shipments to, that person.
